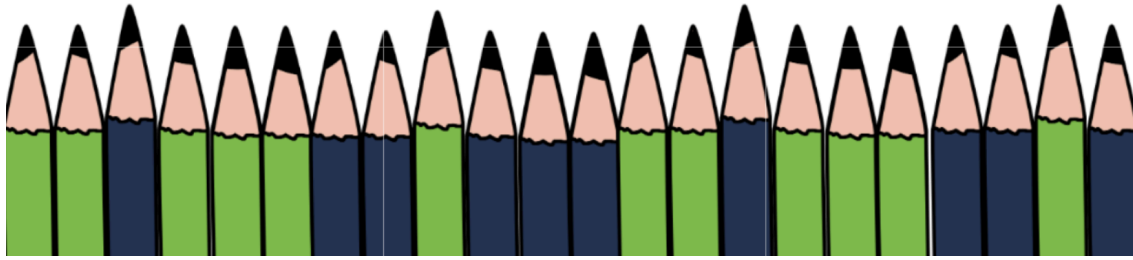

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## **Sbotolau Clinigol Wolfson – Cynyddu mynediad i driniaethau seicolegol ar gyfer problemau gorbryder plant**

Yn ddiweddar, fe wnaeth ein cydweithwyr yng Nghanolfan Iechyd Pobl Ifanc Wolfson recordio gweminar yn canolbwyntio ar y triniaethau seicolegol ar gyfer gorbryder ymhlith plant.

Mae problemau gorbryder yn gyffredin ac yn aml yn dechrau'n gynnar mewn bywyd. Fodd bynnag, bach iawn o deuluoedd sy'n troi at gymorth seiliedig ar dystiolaeth pan fyddent yn gallu elw arno yn y lle cyntaf. Thank you to everyone for registering for The 2024 SHRN Student Health and Well-being Survey in primary schools. You should by now have received the survey packs that we emailed to you on 6 September, and the live survey link from Ipsos, emailed w/c 8 September 2024.

**If you haven't received either of these, please contact [primaryshrn@cardiff.ac.uk](mailto:primaryshrn@cardiff.ac.uk) as soon as possible, as they are essential for completing the survey successfully.**

The survey opens for learners at **8am on Monday 16 September 2024**, and you will **have until 3.30pm on Friday 20 December 2024** to finish surveying your learners.

We will also be running The SHRN [School Environment Questionnaire \(SEQ\)](#), alongside to enable registered schools to complete all SHRN activities during one 'SHRN Term'.

The SEQ enables schools to look at how their well-being policies can affect the outcomes of their student survey.

*We're really excited to be adding this fact sheet to our portfolio. It is a vital product to for anyone wanting to find out more about The SHRN School Environment Questionnaire (SEQ). The fact sheet contains information about what the SEQ is, its benefits for schools and wider stakeholders, and provides details about the 2024 data collection for primary schools.*

*The SEQ, used in combination with the biennial SHRN Student Health and well-being survey creates a unique and comprehensive dataset to explore links between school policies and practices (e.g. school leadership; school ethos; school environment; curriculum learning; family and community engagement) and learner health and well-being outcomes.*

*Both the SHW and the SEQ survey have been identified as key data sources that support schools in embedding a Whole-school Approach to Emotional and Mental Well-being, and SEQ data is used by participating schools as an auditing mechanism to prepare for and evidence practice for Estyn school inspections.'*

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## A Wolfson Clinical Spotlight - Increasing access to psychological treatments for child anxiety problems

Our colleagues in [The Wolfson Centre for Young People's Health](#) recently recorded a webinar focusing on the psychological treatments for anxiety in children.

Anxiety problems are common and often start early in life. However, few families access evidence based support when they could first benefit from it. Following detailed explorations of what families want and need to overcome barriers to support for preadolescent children, Wolfson have recently focused on using therapist-supported digital approaches to help parents and carers to help their children. This webinar will give an overview of some of this background as well as findings from recent trials that highlight the promise of this approach for treatment and prevention.

The webinar is relevant to a range of practitioners interested in young people's mental health and anxiety in particular.
